NUSTAR Resort and Casino is equipped with an automatic fire detection and alarm system, seamlessly integrated with a comprehensive fire suppression sprinkler system. This advanced setup ensures rapid detection and immediate response, providing maximum protection in the event of a fire emergency.


To further strengthen its safety framework, NUSTAR maintains a dedicated Safety Officer on duty 24/7, tasked with the continuous enforcement and monitoring of all safety protocols across the property. A highly trained Emergency Response Team (ERT) is also on standby at all times, ready to respond swiftly and effectively to any emergency whether fire-related, medical, or other critical incidents ensuring the safety and well-being of all guests and employees.

In support of medical emergencies, NUSTAR houses an on-site clinic for guest operated by qualified healthcare personnel, providing immediate medical attention to guests and staff when needed. This is further complemented by an available ambulance service for prompt transport and response to more serious medical situations.





# What To Do During Emergency

## What to Do When You Hear a Fire Alarm

### 1.Stay Calm

Do not panic. Keep calm and listen for announcements or instructions.

### 2.Do Not Use Elevators

For your safety, always use the stairs during a fire alarm.

### 3.Leave the Room Immediately

Take your essential items only if it is safe to do so.

## 4.Follow Exit Signs

Proceed quickly but calmly to the nearest emergency exit.

#### 5.Assist if You Can

If someone nearby needs help and you can safely assist, please do so.

#### 6.Close Doors Behind You

Close the door to your room to help prevent the spread of smoke and fire.

## 7.Report to the Assembly Area

Once outside, go to the designated assembly point. Follow the guidance of emergency staff.

#### 8.Do Not Return Inside

Only re-enter the building when the authorities declare it safe.

# i What to Do During an Earthquake

If You Are Inside the Building:

### 1.Stay Indoors and Stay Calm

Do **not run outside**. It's safer to remain where you are during the shaking.

## 2.Drop, Cover, and Hold On

- **1. Drop** to your hands and knees to prevent falling.
- **2. Cover** your head and neck under sturdy furniture (like a table or desk), or protect yourself near an interior wall.
- **3. Hold On** to the furniture until the shaking stops.

#### 3. Avoid Windows and Glass

Stay away from windows, mirrors, and glass doors to avoid injury from shattering glass.

#### 4.Do Not Use Elevators

Use stairs only **after** the shaking stops and it's declared safe to evacuate.

#### 5. Wait for Official Instructions

Once the tremor ends, wait for announcements or guidance from hotel staff or emergency responders.

### If You Are Outside:

### 1.Move to an Open Area

Stay away from buildings, trees, power lines, and anything that could fall.

#### <sup>l</sup> 2.Protect Your Head

Use your arms or any item to shield your head from falling objects.

### After the Earthquake:

### 1.Prepare for Aftershocks

These can happen within minutes. Stay alert and repeat "Drop, Cover, and Hold On" if needed.

#### 2. Evacuate If Instructed

If evacuation is necessary, follow staff instructions and proceed to the designated assembly area.

### 3. Report Injuries or Damage

Inform hotel staff immediately if anyone is hurt or if you notice unsafe conditions.


### 4.Do Not Re-enter the Building

Only return inside once it is officially declared safe.





# **Emergency Situation Flowchart**






# **Emergency Evacuation Areas**
